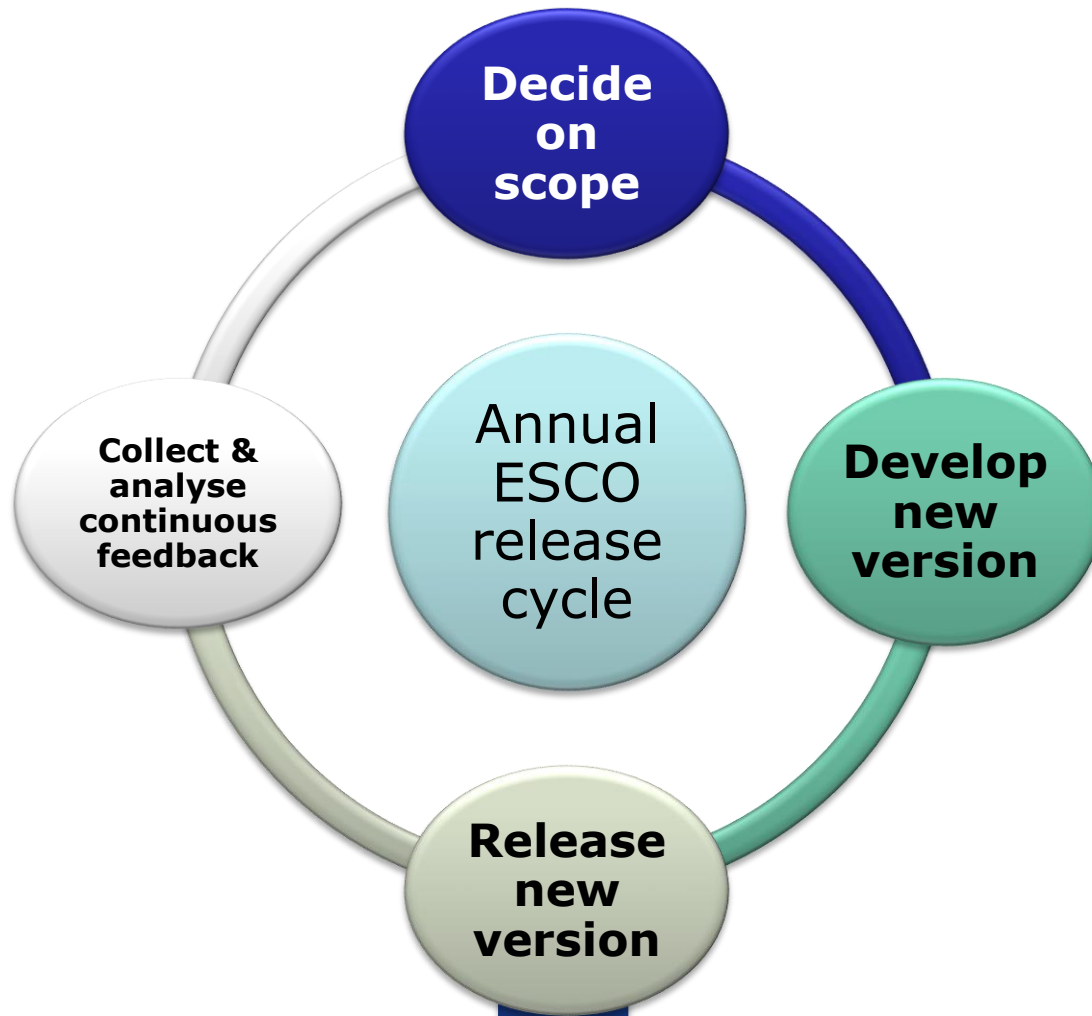

Purpose

Overview of the annual ESCO cycle



Collect & Analyse continuous feedback

- Stakeholders (content experts, classification experts, users of ESCO)
- Big data analysis
- Feedback by the custodians of the National classifications systems

Decision on the scope

- Define the focus of the next release (e.g. review of specific sectors, cross-sectoral topics or new featured).
- Consultation of:
 - Experts in Member States
 - Classification experts



Develop new version

- Stakeholders engagement
- Knowledge engineering
- Dialogue with stakeholders and classification experts
- Quality assurance
- Translation

Release new version

- Commission decides on the release of the new version after consulting:
 - Experts
 - Classification experts
- After release: use the new version in EURES
