What do we want to achieve?

- keep stakeholders on board after the end of the online consultation and the SREF
- continue receiving feedback from stakeholders
- support implementation of ESCO in applications





Stakeholder group 1: domain experts

- There is a need for introducing "Energy Auditor" as an occupation to ESCO.
- I would like to see "iOS/Swift" to be added to the knowledge concepts representing a new programming language.
- Can we revisit the terms defined for Greek for the managerial occupations? We do not think the current terms support the user interfaces of our PES system very well.
- We have these 5 occupations defined for Beach Clubs. Can we capture these in ESCO or should we create a local extension?





Stakeholder group 1: domain experts

- Experts that can provide input on the contents in ESCO (occupations, knowledge, skills, competences)
- Includes e.g. public and private employment services, social partners, representatives of professional associations





Stakeholder group 2: (potential) ESCO users

- When I replace the ESCO API 1.2 by ESCO API 1.3 I get Java Exception Error 1638. Are other users encountering this error too?
- I observe that the ESCO2ISCO map refers to ISCO. Where can I download ISCO in RDF?
- I have difficulty to create an user-friendly "skill-picker" dialogue. Can someone show me some good examples?
- I seem to be able to query for occupations, skills and qualifications, however, I am not able to retrieve the terms defined for the concepts. What do I do wrong?
- I have created this tiny "skill-picker" dialogue in java. If you want to use, feel free to download it from my site.
