Enrich information on qualifications by linking their learning outcomes to skills

Employers grasp qualifications' labour market value in a cross-border context

Individuals improve chances on labour market through better matching



Automated approach for linking qualifications to skills

Test an automated approach based on Natural Language Processing


Initial degree of human intervention

Tests in national qualifications databases

Qualification owners – awarding bodies to control enriched content



Natural Language Processing (NLP)



Enable computers to understand and process common human language instead of only programming languages



Purpose of testing

To observe extent and how machine learning has positive effects

Give insight in extent and nature of human intervention to correct errors

Explore use of ESCO mapping platform



Pilot features

Examine limited number of diverse qualifications in different national databases

Different description styles in min 3 languages

National Qualification Frameworks referenced to EQF

VET and Higher Education qualifications

Candidate Member States



Follow up to testing

If positive result, adapt ESCO to show links between qualifications and skills

Possibilities for linking:

- → Manual linking if MS databases provide no automatic linking possibilities
- → Automated linking to be validated and corrected by human experts



Comparability of learning outcomes

Learning outcomes descriptions need to become more comparable

Guidelines on writing learning outcomes

Usefulness of a common format for learning outcomes



Linking is voluntary

Voluntary character of ESCO
