Experts from public employment services, statistical organisations, chambers of commerce, the ILO and other key stakeholders

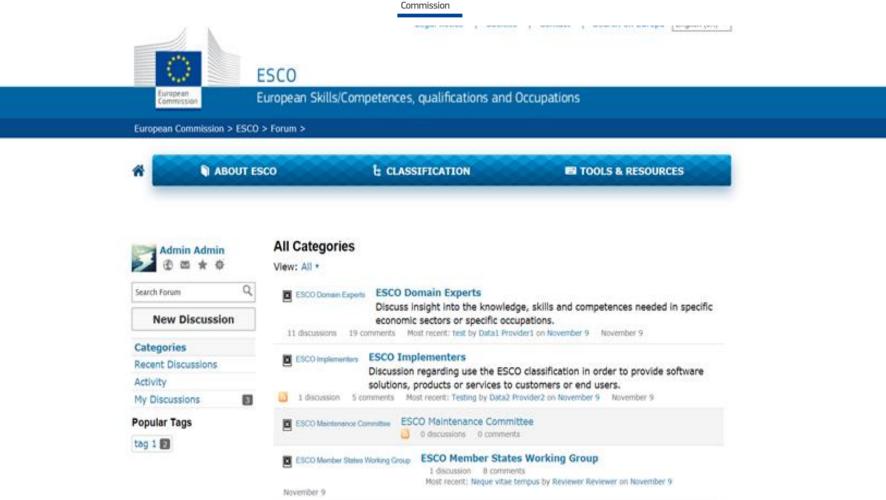
