








## Downloads of ESCO API and datasets

















## **Evolution of the ESCO qualifications pillar**

Qualifications in ESCO



#### Number of qualifications in ESCO




% of qualifications linked to ESCO skills







### **Conceptual and terminological coverage of ESCO**



## *Terminological coverage by language*




## Terminological coverage by economic sector
