- 19 people responded
 - ESCO Board: 6
 - ESCO Maintenance Committee: 8
 - ESCO Secretariat: 5

Recurring Themes

1. ESCO has value
2. Concerns about involvement of stakeholders
3. Concerns about quality
4. Qualification pillar not understood
5. Concerns about translations
6. Call for pragmatism
7. ESCO needs to be explained better



Mitigations to discuss

1. Agree on programme with PESs to map to national classifications
 - a. Merge terms and synonyms
 - b. Extend ESCO where appropriate
2. Demonstrate Technical Specification for Qualifications in practice
3. Execute on Communication Strategy
