1 ESCO V1.2 INCENTIVE

The European Commission started discussions with EU Member States and stakeholders (public and private) to tackle the growing challenges of the EU labor market and changes in the sphere of education and training, which has given impetus for the new ESCO major version.



2 LABOUR MARKET AND DATA ANALYSIS

Using AI tools and adhering to the ESCO methodological approach, the two-year process of developing a new version started, involving qualitative and quantitative revisions of the classification.

3 CONSULTATIONS

The consultation process allows Member States and stakeholders to provide feedback on new concepts and adjustments in the new major version of ESCO.



4 FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AND TRANSLATION

Analyzing feedback and translation of new concepts in 28 ESCO languages, followed by Member States' input on the translated versions.



5 ESCO V1.2 RELEASE

Integration of feedback culminates in the release of ESCO V1.2, publicly accessible and offered in all 28 languages, ensuring valuable insights for stakeholders and contributing to the European Year of Skills.
